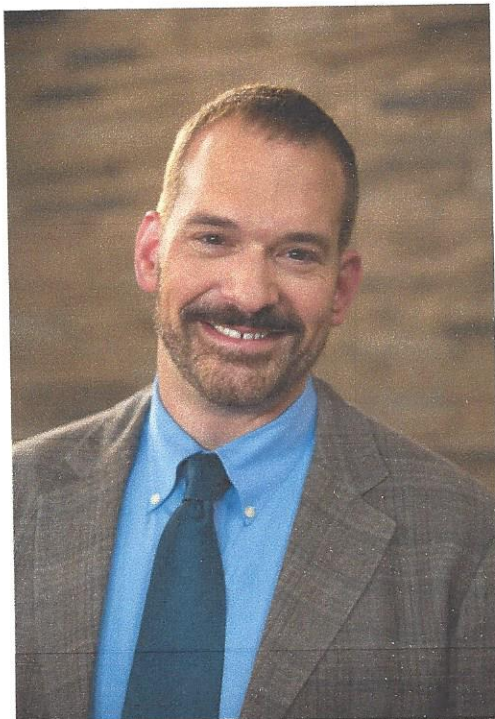


Join the San Antonio Genealogical & Historical Society for our 60th Annual Seminar!
