

# Introduction

This index is to a genealogy quarterly called the Los Bexarenos Genealogical Register. The Register has been published every year since 1984. With the year 2011, there are twenty-eight volumes of the Register.

This index has been organized in three parts: Selected Articles, Register Contents by locality, and Wills and Estates. Our records primarily are from the state of Texas and the three contiguous states in Mexico; Coahuila, Nuevo Leon, and Tamaulipas. This area is popularly referred to as Northeastern Mexico during the colonial period.

Complete sets of all volumes of the Los Bexarenos Genealogical Register are located in the San Antonio Public Library, the Clayton Library in Houston, the Benson Collection at U.T. in Austin, the DRT library at the Alamo, The S.A.G.H.S. Library in San Antonio, and in the Corpus Christi Public Library.
